Cathrine E. Keller, MD served as President of Lake Medical Imaging and of Radiology associates of Central FL from 2005 to 2023 and has been a radiologist at the practice since 1988. Dr. Keller established the first in the U.S. freestanding ACR Diagnostic Center of Excellence and Florida's first ACR Breast Imaging Center of Excellence and expanded Lake Medical Imaging from two to six locations. Dr. Keller was an early adopter of genetic testing for breast and prostate cancer risk, CEM breast imaging and Al integration.

Dr. Keller is a chamption for women's imaging, including Mammography, CEM, Breast MRI and Ultrasound. Dr. Keller has received 4 RBMA RAD Honors in the last 3 years.
